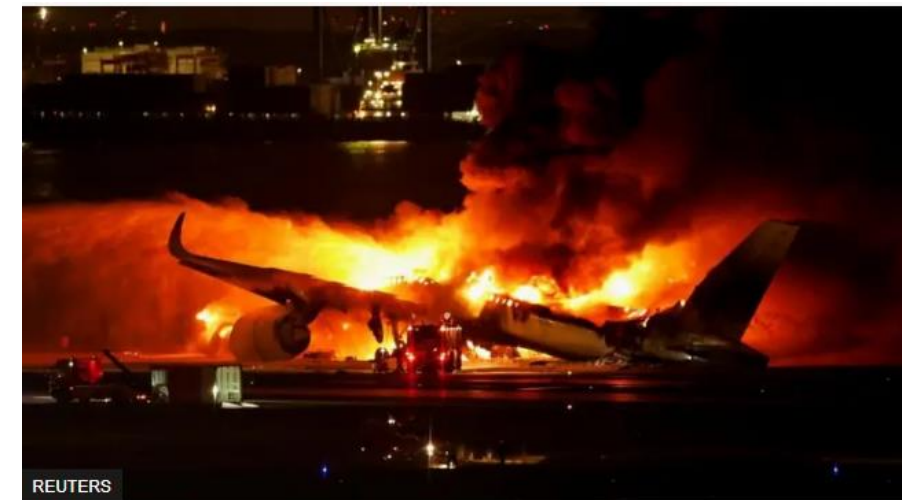

2024 Haneda Airport runway collision

- January 2, 2024: Tragedy at Tokyo International Airport (HND)
- Upon landing, JAL Flight 516 collided with a Japan Coast Guard (JCG) aircraft on the runway, resulting in a fire engulfing both aircraft.
- Of the six JCG aircraft personnel, five perished. The captain sustained serious injuries.
- The JAL aircraft carried 379 souls (367 passengers and 12 crew members) , all passengers and crew evacuated successfully.

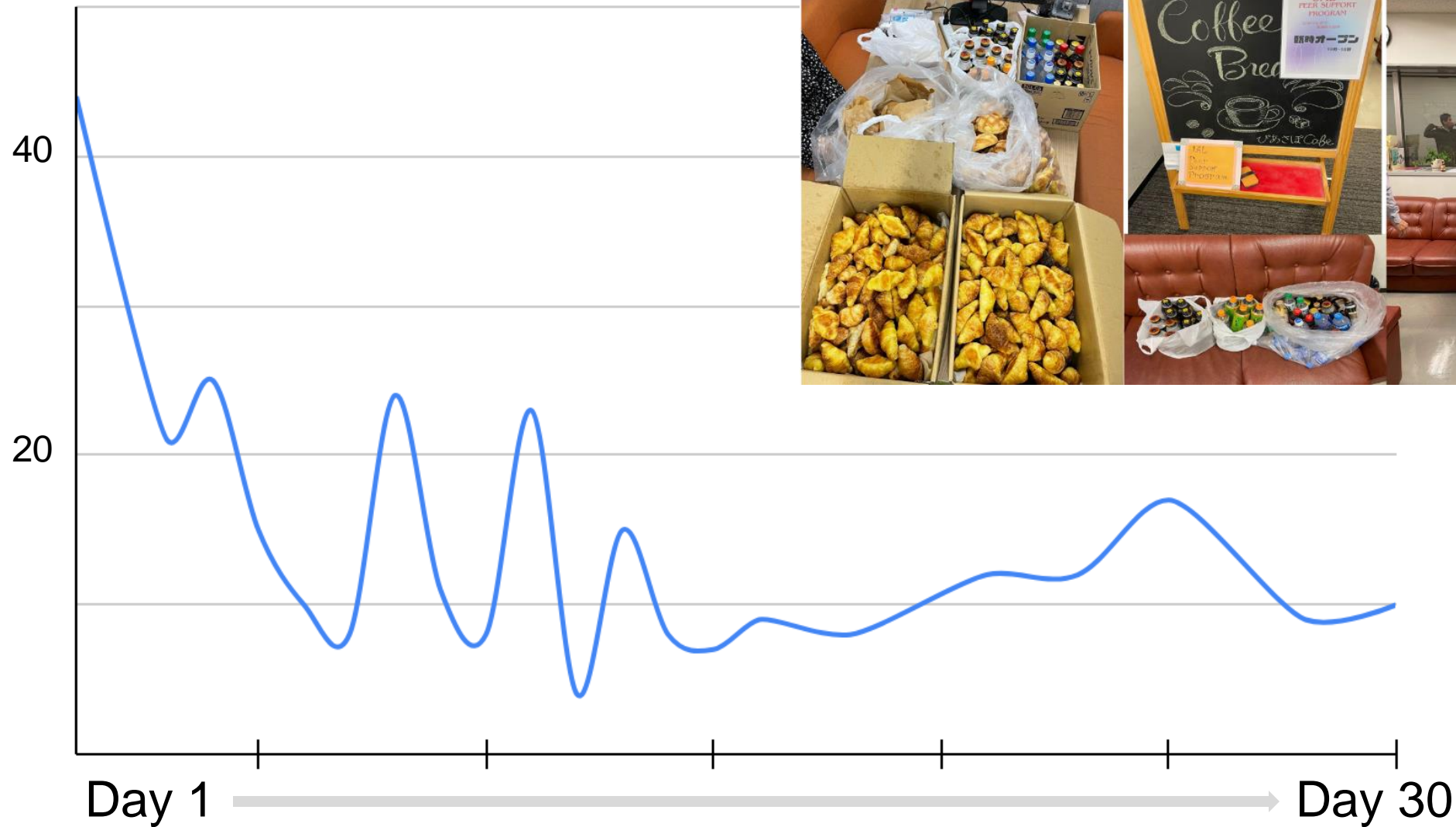

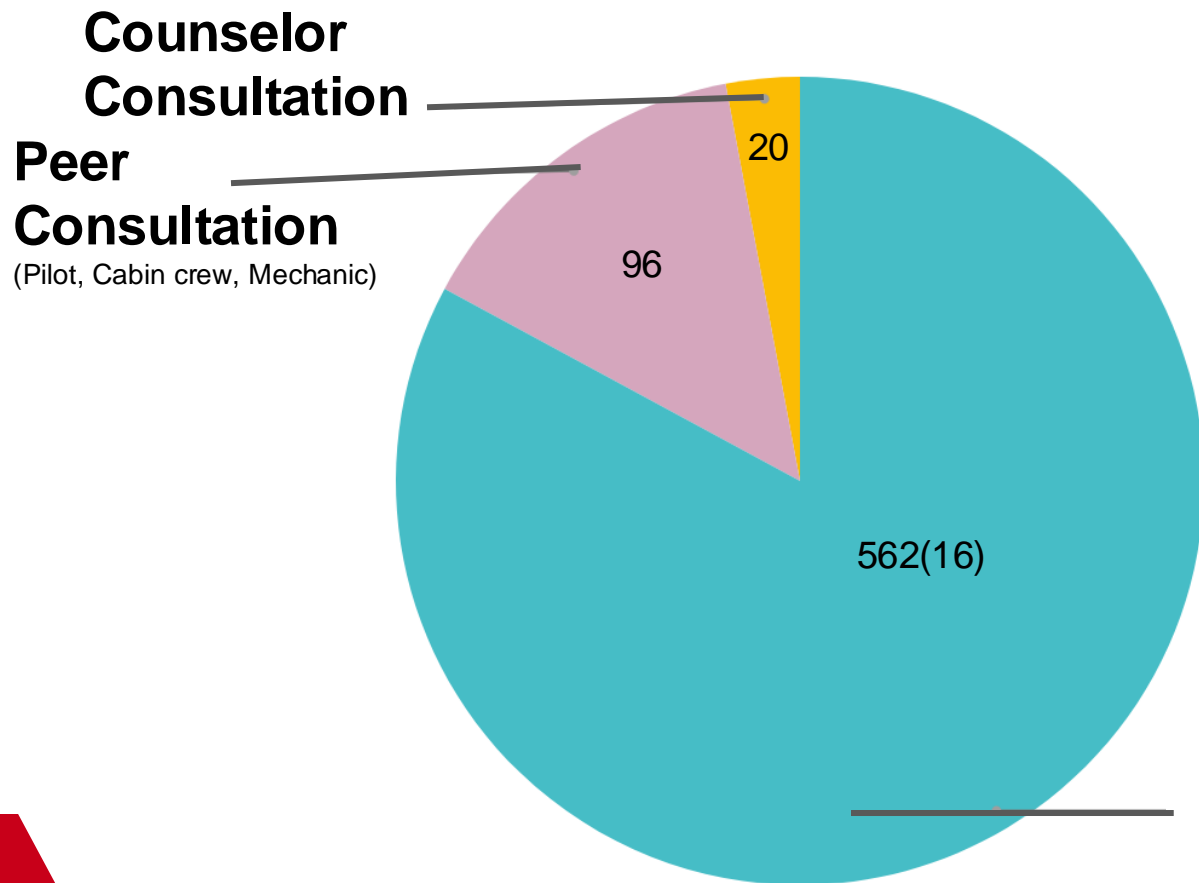
