

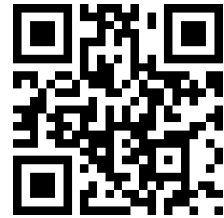


## 2025 IPAAC CONFERENCE CALL FOR PRESENTATIONS

Please submit your abstracts for proposed plenary presentation, panels, and workshops for the November 11-13 2025 IPAAC Conference in Montreal, Canada!

Submissions should be submitted electronically to:

In that e-form, submitters will be asked to include the following information:

- 1) Presentation Type:
  - a) Speaker; 45 minutes: 1 speaker
  - b) Panel; 90 minutes: 3-4 speakers (including the session chair)
  - c) Workshop; 90 minutes
- 2) Speakers: names, credentials, affiliations, contact information.
- 3) Abstract: provide a summary of the ideas, points and takeaways that attendees should expect from your presentation (no more than 500 words; if you are submitting a panel, the abstract should be inclusive of all speakers).
- 4) Learning Objectives: include two learning objectives for each speaker for the session (i.e. a panel with four speakers should have 8 learning objectives. For example; 'The participant will be able to describe how body language can support active listening')
- 5) Conflicts of Interest and Disclosure Statement: All presenters will be asked to disclose potential conflicts of interest related to commercial products or services.
- 6) Audiovisual Needs: Outline what AV needs the session will require to support the learning objectives.

Submissions will be accepted starting Feb 15, 2025 and will remain open until June 15, 2025.

The conference review committee will review all abstracts and assess for clarity, relevance, and interest related to the intended conference audience. Presentations primarily addressing or promoting a commercial product or service will not be considered. The Program Review Chair reserves the right to exclude a submission if it is felt to meet this criterion.

Speakers attending the entire conference will be offered a 33% discount on their registration fee.

Speakers attending only on the day of their presentation will not be required to pay the registration fee.
